

RESOLUTION TO FORWARD DUG HILL ROAD SURVEY TO NYS LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, the Town Road known as Dug Hill Rd is an approximate 5 mile road maintained by the Town of Hurley Highway Department which runs through the Catskill Forest Preserve overseen by the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation Department, and

WHEREAS, the NYS Legislature adopted a program to allow towns to identify dangerous areas along town Right of Ways bordered by NYS Forest Preserve Lands protected under Article 14 of the NYS Constitution. These problem areas can then be surveyed, and town board adopt a resolution to forward to the NYS Legislature for their approval to allow NYS DEC to set a purchase price for the sale of said property to the town to correct the problem area along town road, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hurley Highway Superintendent, Michael Shultis has identified an area of Dug Hill Road as a liability to both the town and NYS DEC due to falling rocks onto a section of road identified in survey map completed by Brinnier and Larios, Town Engineers and attached herewith, and

WHEREAS, the NYS DEC Land is identified as 0.4 ac of lot SBL 47.3-2-7 and/or 55.2-1-6, so

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED TO, to adopt this resolution and authorize the town Highway Superintendent to forward a copy of this resolution along with the Survey Map and cover letter to the NYS Legislature for further approval.
