

RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE BRUSH CHIPPER

WHEREAS, the Town of Hurley Highway Department maintains approximately 54 miles of town roads, and

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent maintains an annual schedule of cutting back brush overgrowth and dead trees along said roads, and

WHEREAS, the February 4, 2022 Ice Storm caused wide spread damage throughout town causing crews to clear an inordinate amount of brush using our current Morbark Chipper, and

WHEREAS, the current Morbark Brush Chipper is over 25 years old and in need of replacement, and

WHEREAS, the highway superintendent has received a quote from A. Montano Co Inc. via Sourcewell Contract #031721-MBI, to purchase a 2022 Morbark Model 1821 not to exceed \$85,000 of the NYS CHiPS Funding to, and

WHEREAS, the town board will appropriate funds from Capitol Funds 3H Equipment for the initial purchase and submit invoice to NYS DOT for reimbursement from annual CHIPS Program to deposit back in Capitol Fund 3H, so

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, to authorize the Highway Superintendent to place the order for a 2022 Morbark Chipper Model 1821 thru Sourcewell Contract #031721-MBI under Town of Hurley Member ID#152878
