

**Recycling Policy in Municipal Buildings**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hurley already recycles at Town Hall; and

**WHEREAS**, the Climate Smart Task Force has requested a specific policy in order to demonstrate Hurley is a Climate Smart Community;

**WHEREAS**, The Town of Hurley recognizes that disposal of solid waste in landfills is costly to town taxpayers and increases greenhouse gas emissions; and

**WHEREAS**, recycling provides a mechanism to significantly reduce solid waste disposal amounts; and

**WHEREAS**, placing recycling bins in convenient, well-marked locations increases the rate of recycling;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Board of the Town of Hurley requires that in municipal buildings, wherever there is a trash bin, there must also be a recycling bin, with signage designating which bin is for which.
