

RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE SOFTWARE TO ASSIST CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIALS WITH ENFORCING SHORT TERM RENTAL LAW

WHEREAS, the Town of Hurley has had a Short Term Rental Law in effect since 2021; and

WHEREAS, over the past six months the Town of Hurley Code Enforcement Officials have been consistently responding to complaints regarding Short Term Rentals; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hurley Code Enforcement Officials have found it difficult to enforce the Short Term Rental Law without additional tools to actively identify units listed to ensure that they meet current fire and safety standards; and

WHEREAS, Granicus software has given a lengthy demonstration of their services and has been determined to be the best fit for the Town of Hurley’s Short Term Rental Enforcement needs; and

WHEREAS, the cost of Granicus has been included in the 2023 Budget Adopted November 14, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, to contract with Granicus to assist the Town of Hurley Code Enforcement Officials at a cost of \$10,647.19 from line A3620.4.
