The applicant, Arizona Hudson Valley LLC, proposes to renovate an existing resolt facility located at 198 Heritage Drive in the Town of Hurley, Ulster County, the former Twin Lakes Resort. Existing buildings will be renovated or rehabilitated. New construction includes 48 mobile cabins, a wastewater treatment plant, a parking lot, and driveways. Actions specific to DEC permit jurisdiction are as follows:

Endangered and Threatened Species
The applicant proposes an incidental taking of
the endangered northern cricket frog (Acris crepitans). The take includes the adverse modification
of, and impainnent of essential behaviors on, six
acres of occupied habitat. In addition to minimizing impacts, the proposed Net Conservation Benefit includes 22 acres of the site piaced in conservation
study to develop a management plan for the site,
and restoring areas of disturbance to previously
existing conditions to maximum practicable extent.
