WHEREAS, the Town of Hurley (the "Town") and United Public Service Employees Union ("UPSEU") are parties to a Collective Bargaining Agreement for the term January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the parties have engaged in good faith negotiations in an effort to arrive at a successor Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA"); and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached a tentative settlement covering the period January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025 and further wish to commit such to writing; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto agree that the current CBA and all its terms and conditions of employment set forth shall remain in full force and effect except as herein modified; and

WHEREAS, unless otherwise noted, all changes shall be prospective from the ratification of the Memorandum of Agreement ("MOA"); and

WHEREAS, both the Town and UPSEU negotiating committees agree to recommend the MOA for approval and recommendation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Hurley, that the Memorandum of Agreement between the Town of Hurley and the United Public Service Employees Union, as attached hereto, is approved and authorizes the Supervisor to sign any final agreement documents consistent therewith, including the final collective bargaining agreement.
