WHEREAS, there does not exist a body that can focus on town safety; and

WHEREAS, the Town needs to review and update its Emergency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to address Emergency Medical Services (EMS), road safety and disaster preparation; and

WHEREAS, the committee will consist of no more than 13 members, drawn from Town departments and residents, as well as advisory members from key Ulster County divisions; and

WHEREAS, the town departments and Ulster County will put forth candidates for the committee, and will solicit volunteers from town residents; and

WHEREAS, once formed, the committee will elect a chairperson, vice chairperson and secretary; and

WHEREAS, Deputy Supervisor John Perry and Town Council Member Debbie Dougherty will sit on the committee as liaisons and coordinate with the Fire Departments, Town departments and the Ulster County organizations,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Hurley to approve the formation of a Town of Hurley Safety Committee consisting of:

Five (5) town residents

One (1) member each from the Hurley and West Hurley Fire Departments

One (1) member each from the Hurley and West Hurley Fire Departments EMS squads

One (1) member each from the Highway and Building Departments

Two (2) advisory members, one (1) each from the Ulster County Sheriff’s Department and the Ulster County Emergency Management Division.
