WHEREAS, time is needed to review land use and environmental studies and consider updates to the Town Comprehensive Plan,

WHEREAS, that the Town Board voted to pass Resolution #2019-86 and enact a moratorium on the dated of May 20, 2019

WHEREAS, to address procedural concerns and the recommendations of the Ulster County Planning Board, the Town has conducted additional review and amended the proposed moratorium.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board enacts this moratorium on the date July 15, 2019 to replace and supersede Resolution #2029-86.
