AGREEMENT FOR THE EXPENDITURE OF HIGHWAY MONEYS **Section 284 OF THE HIGHWAY LAW**

AGREEMENT between the Town Superintendent of Highways of the Town of Hurley, of Ulster County, State of New York and the undersigned members of the Town Board.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, the revenues from equipment rentals, reimbursement for snow and ice removal and other charges for services, the reappropriated funds, and the CHIPS and other State aid for highways, shall be expended as follows:

- GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$370,000.00 shall be set aside to be expended for basic work and general maintenance and repairs upon 54.00 miles of town highways, including sluices, drainage ditches, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet, tree and brush removal, board walks, sidewalks that are the responsibility of the Town, emergency activities as such are authorized by the Town Board, and other activities involved with the care, upkeep and maintenance of highways and bridges of the Town.
- PERMANENT IMPROVEMENTS HIGHWAYS. The sum of \$300,000.00 shall be 1B. set aside to be expended for the permanent improvements of Town Highways. The Town Highways that are intended to be improved include:
 - a) On a street known as Conifer Lane, commencing at Lucas Tpk to cul-de-sac, a distance of 0.30 miles. Mill road surface, apply Tack Coat and 500Tons Type 6 Blacktop Estimated Cost: \$41,400.00
 - b) On a street known as **Summit Ave**, commencing at Zandhoek Rd to Conifer Ln, a distance of 0.19 miles. Mill road surface, apply Tack Coat and 280Tons Type 6 Blacktop **Estimated Cost: \$26,300.00**
 - c) On a street known as Edgewood Dr, commencing at Lucas Ave and ending a distance of 350 feet. Mill road surface, apply Tack Coat and 110 Tons Type 6 Blacktop Estimated Cost: \$10,000.00
 - d) On a street known as West Street, commencing at Zandhoek Rd to North

Rd, a distance of <u>0.14 miles. Mill road surface,</u> 280Tons Type 6 Blacktop <u>Estimated Cost: \$16,800.00.</u>

- g) On a street known as Rowe Ln, commencing at John St going ending at Wall St, a distance of <u>0.05 miles</u>.
 40 Tons Type 6 Blacktop <u>Estimated Cost \$2,400.00</u>.
- h) On a street known as <u>Orchard St.</u> commencing at Foertner Rd to Hillside Ln, a distance of <u>0.30 miles</u>.
 280 Tons Type 6 Blacktop <u>Estimated Cost: \$16,800.00.</u>
- i) On a street known as <u>Mosher Place</u>, commencing at State Rt 375 to Clover St., a distance of <u>0.11 miles</u>. Mill surface and reconstruct collapsing shoulder for 200 ft
