- Code regarding hawkers and peddlers: the big issue are the fees which are set by the Town Board so no action on our part will assist, except that we can propose to delete the \$5000 surety bond. Peter will look at this again and inform Gregory re fees and progress.
- Regulating drainage and steep slopes (revisiting from last year) Melinda will see if there is budget for Bonnie to work on a map for Hurley.
- Protection against clearcutting (revisiting from last year) Tabled until July.
- Adopting stretch energy in transition so will wait.
